Having trouble hearing on the telephone?? **F.T.R.I.** a non -profit organization will provide a free phone! If you have a hearing loss and are a permanent resident of Florida, the *Deaf Service Center of Pasco Hernando* distributes at **NO Charge** a volume control telephone that provides amplification, tone adjustment, ring flasher & ringer volume adjustment. If you use hearing aids, you will qualify. If you do not use hearing aids, DSCPH host monthly Free Hearing Screening to determine if you may have a qualifying degree of hearing loss. The center is located at 8610 Galen Wilson Blvd.(off Ridge Rd) in Port Richey, Fl. 34668. Call them for more information and/or an appointment time at 727-816-1314.
