Note to pet owners: Pasco County Animal Control Ordinance #79-22

| Sect. 2 | All dogs and cats must have rabies vaccinations |
| Sect. 4.4 | All dogs must wear Pasco County License Tag at all times |
| Sect. 24.4 | It is illegal to own a vicious animal |
| Sect. 7. | All dogs must be under "direct control" at all times by means of a fence, leash, cord, chain any humane means. |

"Failure to abide may result in the impoundage of the animal in violation, the issuance of fine, the issuance of Court Citations or any combinations of the above penalties (maximum fine \$500.00 and/or 60 days in jail." Any questions call 849-3730.
